Open to all Breeds and Mixed Breeds who have a Barn Hunt Open (RATO) title or above earned on or prior to April 30, 2019. Dogs with Barn Hunt Master (RATM) titles or above may enter beginning 6/1/2019, those with Barn Hunt Senior (RATS) titles after 6/15/2019, and those with Barn Hunt Open (RATO) titles after 6/30/2019. The Barn Hunt National is a non-regular competition with cumulative scoring over three days of competition. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded in Grand National, Games, and Versatility. Gold Medal winners will earn the special titles of RGNC, RGC, and RVC.

Grand National & Games Entry Requirements and Entry/Draw Schedule:

Dogs must have an Open title earned prior to April 30 to be eligible for entry into the Barn Hunt National. The title held on April 30 is the title level used for the opening dates below.

Entries will be accepted on a first received basis using the following opening dates:

- Dogs with Master titles and above: Entries open June 1
- Dogs with Senior titles: Entries open June 15
- Dogs with Open titles: Entries open June 30

Dogs may be entered any time after their opening date as above, and before the closing date, but will not get special consideration for their title level if they enter later than the opening date for their title. A waiting list will be maintained.

There is a separate entry form for Games. All entries for the same dog (Grand National plus any Games) must be in the same envelope. If entering Team, all entries for both dogs must be in the same envelope.

- Team dogs may have different level titles (e.g., one dog has a Master title and the other a Senior title).
- Team entries are accepted during the open date period for the dog with the highest title competing in the Team.
- The Grand National and/or Hurdles entry for the dog with the lower level title will be set aside until the opening date for that level.

Entries close July 31.

Entry Limits:

Grand National: 160 dogs

Team: 60 teams/120 dogs

Hurdles: 100 dogs

Cancellation/withdrawals

Cancellations/Withdrawals prior to the closing date of July 31 will be refunded in their entirety. After July 31 and prior to August 31, fees will be refunded if and only if there is a dog on a waiting list to fill that spot.

*Returned Checks incur a \$50 fee, and do not constitute a valid entry

Exhibitor Information

Bitches in season are eligible for entry. All Barn Hunt rules applying to Bitches in Season will be in effect at the National.

The Zipper Spirit Award is given personally by Robin Nuttall to the person she feels has epitomized the spirit of Barn Hunt in the past year. This award is decided by Robin and kept confidential until the banquet.

The RATTIE Award is the People's Choice award, chosen from public nominations for dogs and/or dog/handler teams who have been positively impacted by the sport of Barn Hunt. RATTIE Award information is on the website.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel and show grounds. Hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Any damage to hotels or the event site are the responsibility of exhibitors/handlers and may result in disciplinary action by the Event Committee.

RV Parking: RV spots are available at the show site for \$40 per night (with electricity; \$15 with no services). Reservations will not be taken; availability is first-come-first served. Lighthouse RV Park (1232 Central Expy, Melissa TX, 972-838-4600) is 10 miles from the show site; fees are \$40/night. There are other RV camping options available; contact Deborah Ungles (d_ungles@yahoo.com) for more information.

Directions: Hwy 75 or Dallas North Tollway to US 380. US 380 to Lake Forest Drive (FM 1461), North to County Road 166, right turn, and North again several hundred yards to Myers Park.

General Information:

All dogs must be on leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. Pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers on the site. No flexi-leashes within 50 feet of any ring or crating area. Dogs may not be left overnight at the trial site.

Bring weather appropriate gear. These trials will be indoors, but the building is not climate controlled. Texas in September may be warm or cool. Food and drink **may or may not be available on site** or at nearby fast-food restaurants.

No smoking (including e-cigarettes) is allowed anywhere inside the building.

Schedule of Classes:

- Friday, Course 1 and Team (1st half)
- Saturday, Course 2, Team (2nd half), Hurdles Round 1
- Sunday, Courses 3 and 4, Hurdles Round 2, Medal ceremony

Note: This schedule may change depending on overall entry numbers.

Vendors: There is a \$50/day flat fee, paid directly to Myers Park, for vending at the National. By default this is a 10' x 10' space, but larger spaces may be available by special arrangement. Vendors must provide their own tables and chairs. Electricity may or may not be available. Email Deborah Ungles (d_ungles@yahoo.com) for more information or to reserve your vending space.

Banners: Banners will be displayed at the show site for a \$10 fee. These can be club banners, vendor banners, or individual banners. Please contact Deborah Ungles (d_ungles@yahoo.com) for information on how to submit your banner. [Banners must be retrieved by the owner at the end of the event.](#)

Annual Banquet: Join us Saturday night for the Annual Banquet (location to be announced). Tickets will be available for pre-order before 8/12/2019. Contact Kaylynn Steffen (kstef2003@yahoo.com) for more information. Included in the festivities will be presentation of the Zipper Spirit Award and the RATTIE award.

Check in: Check-in will be Thursday afternoon from 3:00-5:00 PM and Friday morning from 7:00-7:30 AM. Only dogs without a verified height measurement are required to check in. If not included with the entry form and not previously measured for a National, a height card from any major agility organization may be presented, or a measurement will be required. Dogs will be moved in height class as necessary. All entrants will get gift bags which can be picked up during either check-in time.

Grand National and Games Awards:

- All Qualifying dogs in all classes will receive a Qualifying ribbon.
- For each Grand National Course, first through fourth place ribbons will be awarded for each height category (small, medium, large). Course 1 and Course 2 awards and High Course 1 and 2 will be announced after the completion of each course. The Top 50 finishers will be announced after Grand National competition on Saturday. Course 3 and 4 awards will be announced on Sunday after all competition and prior to the medal awards.
- Rat Hurdles will have placements by size, first through fourth, plus High Hurdles Round 1, High Hurdles Round 2, and Overall High Hurdles ribbon
- Team will have placements, no size differentiation, first through fourth, and top team gets High Team ribbon.
- The Grand National Champion will earn a Gold medal, second will earn Silver, and third Bronze.
- The Games Champion will earn a Gold medal, second will earn Silver, and third Bronze.
- The Versatility Champion will earn a Gold medal, second will earn Silver, and third Bronze.
